Content Summary

This course comprises two days at Martha Trust, a home for profoundly disabled young people, with a follow up day some weeks later. Theoretical and applied sessions provide a background to the posture management of the severely disabled person. Management is essential in order to optimise remaining functional ability and to minimise secondary complications associated with this client group. As new social, medical and environmental developments occur, so the depth and complexity of the knowledge and skills required to be to adequately define and manage therapeutic needs of the client group expand. The follow up day provides participants with the opportunity for the application of the theory in the workplace by working on a case study and returning to consolidate learning. i
