Content Summary

Short Course – Introduction to the issues pertaining to the physical management of children and adults who have profound and complex disability. Course objectives to be achieved through lectures, case studies, workshops and practical sessions with clients.

Post Graduate Certificate – In depth study of posture and function. Course provides a foundation in biomechanics and advanced neuroanatomy relevant to posture assessment for people lacking posture control. 600 hours of student effort is required – 120 hours on the 3 teaching weeks and 480 hours over 12 months. Students will be expected to read extensively, review a paper, submit a case study, submit an action plan, undertake a short answer test and throughout the period prepare teaching materials and perform literature searches.

CPD Approval/accreditation

Post Grad Certificate is credit rated by Oxford Brookes University. Satisfactory completion of the course will provide between 40 and 60 credits at Masters level. This course is equivalent to 3 modules of the post-graduate MSc in Rehabilitation at Oxford Brookes University.
